Fine Arts

Ceramics

Love clay and getting messy? Well this is the class for you! You will learn about hand building techniques to create functional pottery and clay sculpture. Pinch, coil and slab methods will be explored as well as a variety of surface designs and decorating techniques. Experimenting with design and decoration techniques, you will create a series of unique clay pieces, functional, sculptural and a combination of both.

Drama

You will explore your personal creativity in the performance of scripted works. You will work on collective creations such as fractured fairy tales and other one-act comedies and perform them for younger audiences.

Hone your acting and dramatic talents by participating in drama exercises, games, and theatre sports type activities. Infusing creative flair into collaborative experiences will be fun and energizing!

Dance

Discover your inner rhythm and tap into your coordination, flexibility, and strength as you learn basic dance moves and work collaboratively to prepare dance numbers. Get your heart rate up and get creative at the same time! You will have the opportunity to work with a community based choreographer in some classes and you may be able to share your talents at special events in the school.

Sculpture

Are you artistic and like working with your hands? Want even more opportunities to express yourself through art? Within this option, we will be exploring the diverse art form of sculpture. Students will learn the fundamentals of three-dimensional form using various materials such as wire, clay, needle felt, and tinfoil. No previous experience necessary.

Mixed Media

Mixed media is a visual art form that will see students combining a variety of techniques and using different fine art media to create unique and interesting pieces. After going over some of the basics, students will be pushed to get creative and see where their imagination can take them. Different media could include work with watercolours, fun with photography, bold lines in ink, intricate shading, pops of coloured pencils and paint, or even elements of sculpture. With mixed media, the artist is free to truly make their work their own!
