Science

- Study the animals of the area: life cycles, habitat, adaptations, environmental conditions
- Observe the flora and fauna of the region

Social Studies

- Compare and contrast the area with your home community
- Visit a museum
- Research information on your vacation spot
- Plot the trip on a map

Math

- Build sand castles incorporating geometric shapes
- Create and solve word problems
- Count and handle the local currency
- Keep track of the number of kilometres you've travelled
- Keep a record of the daily temperatures and compare with home temperatures

Language Learning

- Keep a journal or diary of your trip
- Read a few good books for pleasure, perhaps of local folklore and legends
- Learn a few words in the local language
- Interview people from the area
- Read brochures about the area

- Prepare a talk about the trip for the class
- Watch a local news program and record the 5 W's of local issues

Art

- Take photos of your trip
- Sketch drawings

Physical Education

- Walk, run, swim, bike ride, ski, skate, be active!
- Learn some local games to teach the class

Health

- Make note of the local vegetables, fruits and other foods and dishes
- Keep track of all the different jobs people do to get you to and from your destination.
- Observe the local living conditions
