WHAT DOES "IN GOOD STANDING" MEAN?

Our students represent the school and must exemplify the attitudes and behaviour for which the school stands. Participation in extra-curricular activities is a privilege and students who wish to participate must be in-good-standing at the school.

To be in-good-standing means that you must have fulfilled all the following requirements:

- a) Your school accounts must be paid prior to participating.
- b) Your core subject teachers are satisfied that your assignments are up to date and that you are contributing to the classroom environment in a positive manner.
- c) The office is satisfied that you have been a contributing member of the school community and your record of student conduct is in good order. (Example: incident reports and suspensions)
- d) The librarian is satisfied with your behaviour in the library. Overdue books are returned and payment has been made for lost or damaged library books.
